SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1174, L.D. 1436, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Special Free License Plates for the 100% Disabled Veteran."

Amend the Amendment by striking out in the 5th line the underlined punctuation and words ", without the payment of any fee,"

Further amend the Amendment by striking out in the 5th line from the end before the fiscal note the underlined word "physical"

Further amend the Amendment by striking out everything after the 3rd paragraph.

Statement of Fact

The amendment extends the bill's coverage to veterans who have a disability other than a physical one and also requires the payment of the regular fee for registration, making the fiscal note unnecessary.
