SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 1096, L.D. 1449, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Certain Provisions  
of the Employment Security Law."

Amend the Amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the  
4th and 5th lines from the end and inserting in their place  
the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 16 by striking out all  
of paragraph A and inserting in its place the following:

A. For the duration of any period for which he has been  
suspended from his work by his employer as discipline for  
misconduct, if so found by the commission, or until the claimant  
has earned 4 times his weekly benefit amount in employment by  
an employer.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to insure that a person  
who has been suspended for a long period of time is not  
disqualified indefinitely.
