COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1171, L.D. 1454, Bill,
"AN ACT to Encourage the Maine State Museum Commission to
Acquire Works of Art Beneficial to the State."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"§93." in subsection 5 by striking out all of the first sentence
and inserting in its place the following: 'The commission shall
not, during any fiscal year, assume title to works of art which
have an aggregate value of more than \$100,000, unless:'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

It is not possible to determine an estimated loss of
General Fund revenue; however, as the bill indicates, it is
limited to \$100,000 a year except in those extraordinary
circumstances when the State Budget Officer permits the commission
to exceed that limit.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment limits to \$100,000 the value of art that may
be accepted by the commission in any year and adds a fiscal note.
