COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1163, L.D. 1468, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow the Board of Environmental Protection to Regulate Activities Affecting Sand Dunes under the Alteration of Coastal Wetlands Program."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
