COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1215, L.D. 1494, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Part-time Licenses under the Liquor Statutes."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting
in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §201-A is enacted to read:

§201-A. Part-time license

A part-time license issued pursuant to this Title shall
be valid up to a period of 7 calendar months during the 12-
month period following its issuance. The 7 months need not
run consecutively, but may be divided at the time of issue into
2 periods of 3 and 4 months duration, the fee prorated accordingly
and the months during which the license is valid shall be set
out on the license. Any person making application for a part-time
license shall, on the application, designate which 7 months, or
parts thereof, he wishes the license to be valid.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of
Fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

If enacted, this legislation would result in a loss of
General Fund revenue of \$100,000 for each full year it is in
effect.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the subdivision of the 7-month license period and the proration of fees. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
