COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 1127, L.D. 1498, Bill, "AN ACT to Recodify and Resolve Minor Administrative Problems in the Forestry Statutes; and Reorganize the Maine Forestry District."

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out in that part designated "§8202.", subsection 1, and inserting in its place the following:

- '1. Resources. The director shall maintain sufficient resources, including research materials and technical expertise, within the limits of available funds, in order that the bureau may:
  - A. Respond to requests to identify forest insects and diseases of concern to landowners and municipalities;
  - B. Determine the severity of forest insect or disease problems;
  - C. Provide advice on control measures;
  - D. Refer individuals to other state or federal agencies for technical or financial assistance;
  - E. Determine the results of compliance or failure to comply with recommendations made according to this section; and
  - F. Respond to requests for information on insects, other than forest insects, including their identification and control.

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out subchapter III of chapter 807.

Further amend the bill in section 3 in chapter 807 by renumbering subchapters IV to VII to be subchapters III to  $_{
m VI}$ .

Further amend the bill in section 3 by adding at the end of that part designated \$9324." the following:

4. No person shall kindle or use an out-of-door fire on land of another without permission of the owner, except at public campsites and lunch grounds maintained or authorized by the bureau, state parks and state highway picnic areas. This subsection shall not apply to the use of portable stoves which are fueled by propane gas, gasoline or sterno.

out all of Further amend the bill by striking/section 14 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 14. 12 MRSA c. 215, subchapters I, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, IX-A and XI as amended are repealed.'

Further amend the Bill by adding after section 14 the following:

'Sec. 14-A. 12 MRSA §1203, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 694, §240, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§1203. Control and extinguishment of fires
The director shall be responsible for the prevention,
control and extinguishment of forest fires in the Maine

Further amend the Bill by striking out section 23.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment replaces 2 provisions of existing law that were inadvertently omitted in the recodification. It also removes all changes in the forest fire prevention and protection chapter, including the forestry district tax, by deleting this from the recodification.
