COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1240, L.D. 1502, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Amend the Statutes Concerning the Practice of  
Medicine."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in the 3rd line (same in  
L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "prescribe" and  
inserting in its place the underlined word 'mandate'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of sections  
2 and 3.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 4 to 8  
to be sections 2 to 6.

Statement of Fact

This amendment alters a word in the text of the bill and  
removes the prohibitions against the practice of obstetrics.
