HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1081, L.D. 1517, Bill,
"AN ACT Altering the Organization and Governance of Community
School Districts."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"373." in subsection 5 by striking out all of the first
underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following:
'No member of the district school committee, nor a member of
his household nor the spouse of a member of the committee, shall
be employed as a full-time employee in any school operated by
the district or by a member town or administrative unit in the
district.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the employment
limitation to include any member of the household of a member
of the district school committee.
