SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1151, L.D. 1533, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Medical Examiner System."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 4 and
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. 22 MRSA §3024, first ¶, as repealed and
replaced by PL 1977, c. 59, §2, is amended to read:

The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner of the State of
Maine shall be set by the Governor. Other nonsalaried medical
examiners shall, upon the submission of their completed
report to the Chief Medical Examiner, be paid a fee of \$30
for an inspection and view and shall receive travel expenses
to be calculated at the state mileage rate.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section
14.

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the additional \$20 payment in
section 4 and removes the appropriation from the bill.
