COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1281, L.D. 1534, Bill,  
"AN ACT Regarding Laws Relating to Town Lines."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§2001-A."  
underlined  
in subsection 7 by striking out all of the first/sentence and  
inserting in its place the following: 'Municipal boundaries  
need not be perambulated more often than once every 10 years if:'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated  
"§2001-A." by striking out all of subsection 8.

Statement of Fact

This amendment simplifies the bill and deletes subsection 8  
of the proposed law which would have referred disputes over  
the qualifications of a surveyor to the state board that  
registers surveyors.
