COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathbf{A} " to H.P. 1179, L.D. 1535, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Maine Traveler Information Services Law."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. 23 MRSA §1911, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 494, \$1, is amended to read:

2. Number limited. Notwithstanding section 1918 of this chapter, the commissioner shall not issue more than 4 <u>6</u> licenses for official business directional signs for any one place of business, facility or point of interest eligible therefor under section 1909, ...: more than one such official business sign shall be visible to traffic moving in any one public way leading toward the place of business , facility or point of interest nor shall any license be issued for a sign located more than 10 miles radius from the place of business, facility or point of interest, nor shall more than 2 licenses be issued to any one place of business, facility or point of interest for signs of the maximum size specified under section 1910.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering sections 6 through 15 to be sections 7 through 16.

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Statement of Fact

This amendment permits the commissioner to issue 6 licenses to any one business but prohibits him from licensing more than 2 signs of the largest permitted size.
