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**AN ACT Concerning the Salaries which may be Earned by Retired Teachers  
Losing Benefits.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**5 MRSA § 1123**, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 595, § 1, is further amended by adding a new sentence after the 3rd sentence to read:

**Notwithstanding the previous sentence, a teacher's monthly retirement allowance shall not be reduced unless his monthly retirement allowance exceeds twice the difference between 1/12 of his average final compensation at retirement and his monthly retirement allowance.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows a retired teacher who is substituting to earn twice as much as was previously permitted before his retirement allowance is reduced.
