HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1563, Bill, "AN ACT
Converting Lakeville Plantation into the Town of Lakeville and
Removing Lakeville Plantation from the Maine Forestry District."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact
the following:

'Fiscal Note

It is estimated that enactment of this bill would result
in an annual loss of revenue to the State of \$8,500.

Enactment of the bill will also result in some decrease
in costs to the State of approximately \$1,200 annually for
forest service reimbursement.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include a fiscal note
in the original bill.
