SENATE AMENDMENT"A "to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1563, Bill, "AN ACT
Converting Lakeville Plantation into the Town of Lakeville
and Removing Lakeville Plantation from the Maine Forestry District."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in
its place the following:

'AN ACT Converting Lakeville Plantation into the Town of Lake-
ville.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out at
the beginning of the first line the following: "Sec. 2." and
inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out at the
beginning of the first line the following: "Sec. 3." and
inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 2.'

Further amend the bill in section 4 by striking out at the
beginning of the first line the following: "Sec. 4."and inserting
in its place the following: 'Sec. 3.' and by striking out in the
first sentence the figure "5 and inserting in its place the figure
"4"; and by striking at the end the following: "1, 2 and 3" and
inserting in its place the following: '1 and 2'

Further amend the bill in section 5 by striking out at
the beginning of the first line the following: "Sec. 5." and
inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 4.' ;and by striking
out at the end of the first paragraph the following: "1, 2 and
3 of this Act to the following 2 questions" and inserting in
its place the following: '1 and 2 of this Act to the following
question'

Further amend the bill in section 5 by striking out all of that part designated "Question 2"

Further amend the bill in section 5 by striking out everything after that part designated "Question 2" and inserting in its place the following:

'The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the word "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same after the question. This Act shall be approved by a majority of the legal voters voting at the regular or special election, provided that the total number of ballots cast for and against the acceptance of sections 1 and 2 of this Act at the election equaled or exceeded 50% of the total number of votes cast in the plantation for Governor at the last gubernatorial election.

The result of the vote shall be declared by the board of assessors of Lakeville Plantation and due certificate shall be filed by the plantation clerk with the Secretary of State.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. Section 3 of this Act shall take effect upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters at the regular or special election. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall take effect for all purposes hereof at the first town meeting.'
