AN ACT to Direct the Criminal Law Revision Commission to Study Treatment Alternatives for Sex Offenders.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates \$5,000 to the Criminal Law Revision Commission to study possible medical treatment alternatives to incarceration or probation for convicted sex offenders. As part of this study the commission will consult with

medical authorities in the field and with the Departments of Human Services and Mental Health and Corrections. The commission may recommend revisions in the Criminal Code to authorize a treatment alternative and may study the establishment of appropriate treatment programs. ERROR 00012: C2
