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**AN ACT Relating to the Marketing of Potatoes.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

7 MRSA § 1017, sub-§ 1, ¶ M is enacted to read:

**M. That the applicant or licensee has been convicted of a 3rd violation of the provisions of sections 951 to 957, committed during the year from September 1st to August 31st.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that continual violation of the Maine potato branding law may be cause for revocation or suspension of license under the Maine potato licensing law.
