COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1380, L.D. 1605, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Ensure the Prompt Decision of Cases Before the  
Workers' Compensation Commission."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated  
"99-B." by striking out all of the first underlined sentence  
and inserting in its place the following: 'The commissioner  
who hears a case pursuant to section 99 shall render his decision  
no later than 30 days after each party has completed presenting  
its case.'

time limit commences.
