SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to H.P. 1393, L.D. 1613, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to the Vocational-technical Institutes."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 9 and  
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 9. Appropriation. The following funds shall be  
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes  
of this Act.

Vocational-technical Institute from the Waterville salary schedule  
to the state salary schedule.'
