HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 547, L.D. 1614, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide a Special Restaurant Malt Liquor License
in the Town of Georgetown."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in its place the following:

'RESOLVE, Providing a Special Restaurant Malt Liquor License
in the Town of Georgetown.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after
the title and inserting in its place the following:

Findings of fact. The Legislature finds the following
facts:

1. The Town of Georgetown has voted, pursuant to the
Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28, section 101, subsection 3,
that licenses shall not be granted for the sale of malt
liquor to be consumed on the premises of establishments
qualified to sell malt liquor for consumption on premises;
2. That a boat show is scheduled to be held from October
2 to October 9, 1979, at the Robinhood Marina, Inc.,
in the Town
of Georgetown;
3. That, at its 1979 annual town meeting, the Town of
Georgetown voted to request that the Legislature enact
legislation which would provide for the issuance of a special
license allowing the Robinhood Marina, Inc., to sell malt
liquor for on-premises consumption from October 2 to October
9, 1979;

4. That the Robinhood Marina, Inc., operates the only restaurant in the Town of Georgetown; and

Whereas these facts persuade the Legislature that a special malt liquor license should be issued to the Robinhood Marina, Inc., now, therefore, be it

State Liquor Commission authorized to issue a special restaurant malt liquor license. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any other provisions of the law, the State Liquor Commission is hereby authorized to issue a special restaurant malt liquor license valid only at the Robinhood Marina, Inc., facilities and subject to the following conditions:

1. Approval. The license application shall be approved by the municipal officers of Georgetown;

2. Validity. The license shall be valid from October 2 to October 9, 1979, and shall not be renewable;

3. Area of sale. The sale and consumption of malt liquor shall be confined to a designated area only and shall be subject to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28, section 4, relating to business hours; and

4. Fee. The fee for this special license shall be \$40 and shall accompany the application.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to place this resolve in proper form in order to provide a special restaurant malt liquor license in the Town of Georgetown.
