## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 109TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT" To H.P. 1404, L.D. 1617, Bill, "AN ACT Creating a State of Maine Trustees Advisory Board."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Maine's natural resources are made known widely by participation in the exposition; and

Whereas, this legislation is necessary to improve Maine's ticipation and effectiveness in the 1979 exposition; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safet; now, therefore,

Further amend the bill by striking out in the last paragraph 2nd sentence, the following: "nonstate employee members" and inserting in its place the following: 'members who are not employees of the State of Maine'

Further amend the bill in the last paragraph, by striking out in the 5th sentence the following: "be eligible to"

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble this Act shall take effect when approved.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and makes 2 technical changes.
