SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1433, L.D. 1636, Bill, "AN ACT
to Amend the School Finance Law."

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2, 5, 6, 8 and
10.

Further amend the bill in section 9, subsection 3, paragraph
A, by striking out in the first sentence the amount "\$135" and
inserting in its place the following: '\$125'

Further amend the bill in section 9, subsection 3, paragraph
D, by striking out all of subparagraph (3).

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

1. Delete provisions that protect towns in school districts
from having to raise more than their share of the district's state-
local allocation;
2. Delete the requirement that the Legislature adjust the
local leeway provision annually to ensure that the state's share

remains at 40%;

3. Change the per pupil amount for the local leeway provision to \$125; and
4. Delete the appropriation section.
