HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 573, L.D. 1637, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Revise the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Laws."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that  
part designated "§7607." and inserting in its place the  
following:

'§7607. Jigging

A person is guilty of jigging if he fishes for, with a  
hook or hooks manipulated in such a manner as to pierce  
and hook a fish in any part of the body other than the  
mouth, any fish in the inland waters of the State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove an expansion  
of departmental jurisdiction into an area under the jurisdiction  
of the Atlantic/Salmon Commission.
