HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P.
581, L.D. 1639, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections
of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after section 25
of Part B the following:

'Sec. 26. 29 MRSA §1368, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1973,
c. 31, is further amended to read:

2. Police department vehicles. Lights used on police
department vehicles and on motor vehicles operated by chiefs
of police, ~~state-fire-inspecters~~, inland fisheries and ~~game~~
wildlife wardens, sea-and-shore-fisheries-coastal wardens,
Baxter State Park rangers, sheriffs and deputy sheriffs
and law enforcement personnel of the Department of Public
Safety shall emit a blue beam of light.'

Further amend the Amendment in Part B by renumbering
the sections to read consecutively by Title and section.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to see that all law
enforcement personnel of the Department of Public Safety
have the necessary safety equipment when stopping vehicles
for violations of the law.
