SENATE AMENDMENT" B " to H.P. 1456, L.D. 1649, Bill, "AN ACT to Adopt the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Act."

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "§817." by striking out all of the last paragraph.

Further amend the bill in section ⁴ by striking out all of that part designated "§818." and inserting in its place the following:

'§818. Certified copies of custody decree

The State Court Administrator at the request of the court of another state or at the request of any person who is affected by or has a legitimate interest in a custody decree, shall certify and forward a copy of the decree to that court or person. He shall provide copies at cost.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct language in the bill to conform with changes made in ^{the Maine Revised Statutes,} Title 19, section 818.
