HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1478, L.D. 1665, Bill, "AN ACT Creating a Division of Industrial Training."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1507, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:

5-A. Manpower training. The Governor may allocate funds for industrial training.

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of clause the first line after the enacting the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'

rurther amend the Bill in that part designated "<u>\$2421.</u>" in the 3rd line ( 2nd in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "<u>in industries</u>" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'to industries'

by inserting
Further amend the Bill/at the end before the Statement of
Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. 26 MRSA c. 13, sub-c. IX, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 602, \$1, and as amended, is repealed.

Sec. 4. Transitional provision. All unobligated and unexpended fund balances appropriated to the Maine Vocational

Development Commission shall be transferred to the General Fund.

## Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

- 1. Authorize the Governor to allocate funds for industrial training from the Contingency Fund. The uses of the Contingency Fund are specified in the present law and they do not include industrial training;
  - 2. Change a misprint in the L.D.;
- 3. Repeal the present chapter relating to the Vocational Development Commission; and
- 4. Provide that any funds remaining in the account of the Vocational Development Commission shall be transferred to the General Fund.
