HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1484, L.D. 1671, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase Revenues Available to the Department of
Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to Compensate for the Effects
of Inflation on its Current License Fees and its Costs."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 10.

Further amend the Bill by inserting after section 25 the
following"

'Sec. 35 ... 12 MRSA §2553-B, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 387,
is amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph the following
new paragraph:

There shall be a fee for all tournament permits. For
tournaments in which 20 or less persons participate, and
all these participants are members of the club sponsoring the
tournament, the fee shall be \$8. The fee for all other
tournaments shall be \$28.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove from the bill
a provision which would have increased the fee for the seal
on tagging deer from 25¢ to 50¢. It also changes the fees to
be consistent with legislation already enacted.
