HOUSE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 1518, L.D. 1676, Bill,

"AN ACT Appropriating Funds for the Pratt and Whitney Industrial Training Program."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

<u>Appropriation</u>. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for the continuation of the Pratt and Whitney Training Program through March 31, 1980. It is the intent of the Legislature when the request for funding for fiscal year 1981 is made to the Second Regular Session of the 109th Legislature a report of the progress of the training program shall be made. The report shall, among other items detail the amount of funds expended by source, remaining balances by source, if any, and any available new funds by source. It is also intended that an additional request for funds shall be made, if necessary, to continue the program for the 4th quarter of fiscal year 1980.'
