HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1533, L.D. 1682, Bill, "AN ACT to Allocate Money from the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund and to Appropriate Funds from the General Fund for Teachers' Retirement and a Study of the Maine State Retirement System for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1980, and June 30, 1981."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Allocate Money from the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund and to Appropriate Funds from the General Fund for Teachers' Retirement and a Study of the Maine State Retirement System for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1980.'

Amend the Bill by striking out all of sections 7 and 8 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec.

/7. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purpose of this section.

The purpose of this amendment is to change the appropriation for the study of the Retirement System from the Legislative Department to the Department of Finance and Administration. It also removes the appropriation for 1980-81 and the provision restricting the allocation of funds.
