SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1533, L.D. 1682, Bill,
"AN ACT to Allocate Money from the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund
and to Appropriate Funds from the General Fund for Teachers'
Retirement and a Study of the Maine State Retirement System for
the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1980, and June 30, 1981."

Amend the Bill in section 7 by inserting at the end of
the last sentence the following:

'The Joint Standing Committee on
Aging, Retirement and Veterans
shall participate in any study
conducted pursuant to this
section.'
