COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 643, L.D. 1688, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Allocate Money from the Federal Revenue Sharing  
Fund and to Appropriate Funds from the General Fund for Teachers'  
Retirement and a Study of the Maine State Retirement System  
for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1980 and June 30, 1981."

Amend the Bill in section 7 by striking out all of the  
2nd paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting in its place the  
following:

'The committee shall study the funding, contributions,  
benefits, investment policies and all other aspects of the  
Maine State Retirement System. It shall present its findings,  
together with any suggested legislation to the second regular  
session of the 109th Legislature.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 8  
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. Appropriation. The following funds shall be  
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of  
section 7.
