COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1593, L.D. 1704,

Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Statutes Relating to Natural

Gas Pipeline Companies."

Amend the bill in section 1, by striking out in the 8th line (6th in LD) the underlined word "every" and inserting in its place the underlined word: 'any'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by inserting at the end before the period the following: 'within this State'

Further amend the bill in section 2, subsection 2, by striking out in the 7th line (5th in LD) the underlined word "every" and inserting in its place the following: 'any'

Further amend the bill in section 2, subsection 2, by inserting at the end before the period the following: 'within this State'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the bill to show that the authority of the Public Utilities Commission extends only to natural gas pipeline companies that operate in Maine and not to all gas pipeline companies with a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission license regardless of the location of their activities.
