SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
P. 666, L.D. 1720, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit the Department of
Transportation to Acquire Railroad Operating Equipment."

Amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'5. State liability. The State shall not be held liable
in any contract pursuant to this section for the leasing or
purchasing of equipment, facilities or services; for the
delivery of products; for the storage of products, or for any
other service or financial commitment that may result from the
implementation of this section.'
