SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 666, L.D. 1720, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit the Department of Transportation to Acquire Railroad Operating Equipment."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§4207-A." by striking out in subsection 1, at the end before the period, the following underlined words and punctuation: "passenger cars, cabooses and locomotives"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove passenger cars, cabooses and locomotives from the definition of "railroad operating equipment."
