

Amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph by inserting
at the end of the first sentence, before the period, the
following underlined words: 'for the use of the bureau'

Statement of Fact

This amendment restricts wood cutting on State Parks to
that necessary for use within the Bureau of Parks and Recreation.
Timber could not be harvested for resale unless commercial
timber harvesting is required by deed conditions.
