STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT to Limit the Activities Authorized by the Wholesale Seafood License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6851, sub-§ 4, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, § 5, is amended to read:

4. License limited. A license shall only authorize these activities at one establishment or with one vehicle. This license shall not be valid on board a vessel rigged to harvest fish.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill is intended to prevent commercial fishermen from circumventing the commercial fishing license requirements by obtaining a wholesale seafood license.
