Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the first
paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the
following:

'Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Increase the
Limit on Compensation for Assistant District Attorneys in
Prosecutorial District Number 2 and Prosecutorial District
Number 7.

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:'

after the caption "ATTORNEY GENERAL, DEPARTMENT OF" and inserting
in its place the following:

'Attorney General - District Attorneys'

Prosecutorial District 2

Personal Services \$ 5,000

Provides funds to Prosecutorial
District 2 to increase amount
available for salaries for

assistant district attorneys
from \$84,450 to \$89,450 and
to Prosecutorial District 7
to increase amount available
for salaries for assistant
district attorneys from \$44,000
to \$54,000

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase salary amounts
in Cumberland County Prosecutorial District 2 to provide a
juvenile prosecutor for the juvenile caseload now being ignored
in the Portland District Court.
