IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT to Increase the Limit on Compensation for Assistant District Attorneys in Presecutorial District Number 7.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 554-A, sub-§ 5, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 542, Pt. C, § 2. is amended to read:

5. Sums allowed to district attorneys for salaries. For the salaries of assistant district attorneys, the district attorneys shall be allowed annually sums up to the limit as specified in the following schedule:

Prosecutorial District 1	\$50,600
Prosecutorial District 2	84,450
Prosecutorial District 3	82,500
Prosecutorial District 4	74,250
Prosecutorial District 5	74,250
Prosecutorial District 6	54,200
Prosecutorial District 7	44,000 54,000
Prosecutorial District 8	50,600

In addition to the amounts listed in this section, funds shall be provided for fringe benefits for which other state employees are eligible.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the annual sum for assistant district attorneys' salaries for Prosecutorial District 7 from \$44,000\$ to \$54,000.
