COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1658, L.D. 1767, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning Mobile Barber Shops."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§401-A." in subsection 2, by striking out all of the last sentence of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following: 'The rules and regulations shall be limited to rules and regulations concerning requirements which are to be met by mobile barber shops to assure the maintenance of sanitary conditions necessary to protect the health of customers and employees.'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§401-A." in subsection 2, by striking out all of the last 2 blocked paragraphs.

Statement of Fact

This amendment restricts the rule-making power of the board to that necessary to maintain health and sanitation. Because of this limitation, the last 2 paragraphs of the bill are unnecessary.
