"AN ACT Concerning Mobile Barber Shops."


Amend the Bill by inserting before the period at the  
end of subsection 2 of that part designated "§401-A."  
the following underlined punctuation and words:

' , or in any municipality adjacent to a municipality where a  
licensed barber shop was in operation prior to the issuance  
of the special mobile barber shop license '

Statement of Fact

This amendment reduces the possibility of mobile barber  
shops encroaching into areas already served, by excluding them  
from municipalities adjacent to a municipality already served  
by a licensed barber shop.
