SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1658, L.D. 1767, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Mobile Barber Shops."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§401-A."
subsection 2, by inserting at the end of the second paragraph
the following underlined sentence:

'A separate license shall be obtained for each municipality
in which a mobile barber shop operates.'

mobile barber shop must have a separate license for each
municipality in which the shop will operate.
