STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT to Exempt any Tree Growth, within 250 feet from Oceans, Lakes, Rivers or Streams in Organized Municipalities, from the Tree Growth Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 574-A is enacted to read:

§ 574-A. Forest land exempt from taxation

Any forest land in any organized area, which is within 250 feet of the ocean or of any lake, river or stream, is exempt from taxation under this subchapter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The prupose of this bill is to exempt from the Tree Growth Tax land in organized municipalities which is within 250 feet of the ocean or of any lake, river or stream.
