STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT Relating to Confidentiality under the Lottery Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

8 MRSA § 363-A is enacted to read:

§ 363-A. Confidentiality of claim's information

All information required from claimants of prize money and winning tickets as a condition of payment for state lotteries is confidential, except that the Director of State Lotteries may from time to time publish the name and municipality of any person who has claimed a prize or redeemed a winning ticket.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill is proposed in order to prevent the solicitation for money of lottery winners by various organizations and individuals. It will, however, allow the Director of the State Lottery, for advertising purposes, to publish the names of persons who have won prizes.
