Amend the Amendment by inserting after section 2 the  
following:

'Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7101, sub-§5, ¶¶'s I, J and K are  
enacted to read:

- I. Nonresident combination hunting and fishing  
license.....\$87
- J. Alien small game hunting license.....\$50  
(Permits hunting of all species, except deer and bear)
- K. Alien combination hunting and fishing  
license.....\$140'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 4  
the following:

- 'Sec. 5. 12 MRSA §7102, sub-§3, ¶D is enacted to read:  
D. Alien archery license.....\$50

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 7  
the following:

'Sec. 8. 12 MRSA §7151, sub-§5, ¶I is enacted to read:

I. Alien season fishing.....\$50

the following:


'Sec. 12. Effective date. This Act←→takes effect
