COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 694, L.D. 1816, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Bonding of Voting Device Vendors."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'21 MRSA §1064, as amended by PL 1973, c. 585, §12 is
repealed.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the provision of law requiring
a vendor of a voting device to file a bond with the Secretary
of State.
