HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1723, L.D. 1827, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Allocations from the Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years from July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1980 and from July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981, Decrease the State Aid Bonus from 40% to 20%, and Revise Drivers' License and Examination Fees."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 7 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 7. PL 1979, c. 439, Part A, §1, under the caption "16 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY," is amended to read:

Further amend the amendment in section 8 by striking out in that part designated "0330" and inserting in its place the following:

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the implied General Fund appropriation of \$2,000,000.
