SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1723, L.D. 1827, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Allocations from the Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years from July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1980 and from July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981, Decrease the State Aid Bonus from 40% to 20%, and Revise Drivers' License and Examinations Fees."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the first paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the title and before the enacting clause.'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact.
