SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 696, L.D. 1832, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Board of
Environmental Protection's Responsibility to Regulate Roads
under the Site Location Law."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last
underlined sentence before the statement of fact and inserting
in its place the following:

'These standards and any revisions shall be in effect until
90 days after the adjournment of the next regular session
of the Legislature following enactment of this subsection,
unless approved by legislative resolve.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will require affirmative legislative
action to continue these standards in force, so that effective
legislative oversight can be accomplished.
