HOUSE AMENDMENT "1 to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 698, L.D. 1834, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish an Environmental Health Program.

Amend the Amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1662." by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

The department shall establish an environmental health unit within the Bureau of Health. This unit shall be directed by an individual with training and experience in one or more of the following disciplines: Environmental medicine, epidemiology, toxicology, statistics and related fields. The responsibilities of the environmental health unit shall include, but not be limited to:

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$1663." in the 5th sentence, by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "medicine," the following underlined words and punctuation 'occupational medicine,'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of those parts designated "§1664." and "§1665."

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "\$1666." and inserting in its place the following: §1664. Acceptance of funds

The department is authorized to accept any public or private funds which may be available for carrying out the purposes of this chapter.

§1665. Report

The commissioner shall make regular reports to the people of this State regarding the environmental health of the citizens HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 698, L.D. 1834

of the State. He shall also include specific reference to the work of the environmental health unit in an annual report to the Legislature.

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide one health professional to direct the Environmental Health Unit. The amendment also removes from the bill the Department of Human Service's right to promulgate rules and regulations, clearly leaving that authority in the hands of the Legislature. It also removes the department's right of entry and inspection.
