COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 707, L.D. 1843, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Pay Schedule of Physicians to Include
Actuaries."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless
enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there is an urgent need for the Bureau of
Insurance to hire full-time professional actuaries; and

Whereas, the statutory salary level for actuaries employed
by the State is inadequate and effectively precludes their
recruitment; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in
the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

Fiscal Note

This bill will increase the salary of the 2 actuaries in the Bureau of Insurance by \$8,000 each, and would result in an annual cost to a Dedicated Revenue account of \$16,000. This added cost will be offset somewhat by a reduction in expenditures for contractual services.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add to the bill an emergency preamble and an emergency clause.
