Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 3rd line from the end(same in L.D.) the underlined figure "20" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '30'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "20" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '30'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the time period a taxpayer has to respond to a notice of a tax lien from 20 days in the original bill to 30 days.
